RESOLUTION 19-2013

A Resolution Relating to the Assessments for Maintenance Fees for RID 80, RID 06-01, RID 06-02, and RID 06-03

WHEREAS, 7-12-2161(2) MCA requires the Board of County Commissioners to set the assessment of RID's (Rural Improvement Districts) for maintaining, preserving and repairing the improvements, and

WHEREAS, an annual maintenance fee of \$250 per property for RID 80 will be sufficient for repairs and repayment of the County's loan to RID 80, and

WHEREAS, an annual maintenance fee of \$310 per property for RID 06-01 will be sufficient for repairs to RID 06-01, and

WHEREAS, an annual maintenance fee of \$210 per property for RID 06-02 will be sufficient for repairs to RID 06-02, and

WHEREAS, an annual maintenance fee of 8 times the current amounts per property for RID 06-03 will be sufficient for repairs to RID 06-03. The properties that currently pay \$10 annually will be increased to \$80, \$17 currently will be increased to \$136, and \$35 currently will be increased to \$280, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that in accord with 7-12-2161 MCA maintenance assessments for RID 80 be \$250 per property including new lots created within the boundaries of the district since the formation of the district and RID 06-01 be \$310 per property including new lots created within the boundaries of the district since the formation of the district and RID 06-02 be \$210 per property including new lots created within the boundaries of the district since the formation of the district and RID 06-03 be \$80, \$136 and \$280 per property for the three separate fee structures including new lots created within the boundaries of the district since the formation of the district, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the amounts set forth hereto shall remain in effect year to year until changed by the Board of County Commissioners.
