

**RESOLUTION 14-2013**

**RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ADOPT THE TOWN OF TWIN BRIDGES GROWTH POLICY 2013 UPDATE AS A REVISION TO THE MADISON COUNTY GROWTH POLICY 2012 UPDATE**

WHEREAS, through Resolution 11-2013, the Madison County Board of Commissioners adopted the Madison County Growth Policy 2012 Update, which included by reference the Town of Twin Bridges Growth Policy adopted in 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Twin Bridges recently prepared an updating revision to the Town of Twin Bridges Growth Policy adopted in 2003 following the procedures outlined in Chapter 1, Title 76, MCA; and

WHEREAS, the proposed revision meets the standards of a Growth Policy, as outlined in 76-1-601, MCA, and is hereby referred to as the Town of Twin Bridges Growth Policy 2013 Update; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration including holding a public hearing on May 20, 2013, the Madison County Planning Board adopted Planning Board Resolution 1-2013 recommending adoption of the Town of Twin Bridges Growth Policy 2013 Update; and

WHEREAS, 76-1-604, MCA authorizes the Madison County Board of Commissioners to revise a growth policy following the procedures for adopting a growth policy, including adopting a resolution of intention to adopt, adopt with revisions, or reject the proposed growth policy revision; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Board of Commissioners has reviewed the proposed Twin Bridges Growth Policy 2013 Update (attached) and wishes to solicit additional public comment on its inclusion in the Madison County Growth Policy 2012 Update;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Madison County Board of Commissioners hereby:

- (a) Adopts this Resolution of Intention to Adopt the Town of Twin Bridges Growth Policy 2013 Update as a revision to the Madison County Growth Policy 2012 Update; and
- (b) Schedules a public review and comment period, to culminate in a public hearing at 3:00 p.m., on July 16 2013, in the Commissioners Conference Room at the Madison County Annex.
