

RESOLUTION 5-2013

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AN ELECTION ON WHETHER THE MADISON VALLEY RURAL FIRE DISTRICT SHOULD BE ALLOWED TO INCREASE ITS PERMENANT MAINTENANCE MILL LEVY BY SIX MILLS.

WHEREAS, the Madison Valley Rural Fire District Board of Trustees, by Resolution 2 of the Madison Valley Fire District Board filed as Document #148558, has requested to call a special mail ballot election to be held on March 26, 2013, in accordance with the provisions of Title 13, Chapter 19, MCA, for the purpose of increasing its permanent maintenance mill levy by six mills.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that there shall be placed on said March 26, 2013, Special Election Ballot the question in the following form:

Shall the Board of Trustees of the Madison Valley Rural Fire District in Madison County, Montana, be authorized to permanently increase its maintenance levy by six mills to pay the anticipated increased costs of maintaining fire protection, equipment and facilities in the District? It is estimated by the District that the tax increase for a home in the District valued at \$100,000 would have an annual tax increase caused by the additional six mills of \$8.84 and a home valued at \$200,000 would have an annual tax increase of \$17.67.
