

RESOLUTION 37-2010
RESOLUTION OF ROAD NAME CHANGE IN MADISON COUNTY

WHEREAS, in accordance with Madison County Ordinance 3-2000 and Madison County Resolution 15-2010, the Madison County Planning Department and GIS/E911 Mapping Department have initiated the naming of a currently unnamed roadway off of US Highway 287 in the area of the Slide Inn and providing access to multiple Certificates of Survey, Book 7, pages 2014FC and 2061 and Book 5, pages 52 in Section 3, Township 12 South, Range 2 East, PM. To Tremor Lane (Appendix A); and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Planning Office has determined that Tremor Lane does not duplicate an existing road name and has not been reserved for future development; and

WHEREAS, the County Dispatch Supervisor has indicated that the proposed road name change would be a positive change; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing Notice was mailed to all potentially affected Landowners, informing them of an November 9, 2010, County Commission public hearing to consider the proposed road name assignment; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing Notice was published in *The Madisonian* on October 22, 2010 and October 29, 2010, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on November 9, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the following road name change shall be made:

- Existing Road Name: Unnamed **New Road Name: Tremor Lane**

Effective this 9th day of November, 2010.

PASSED and ADOPTED by the Madison County Board of Commissioners this 9th day of November, 2010.

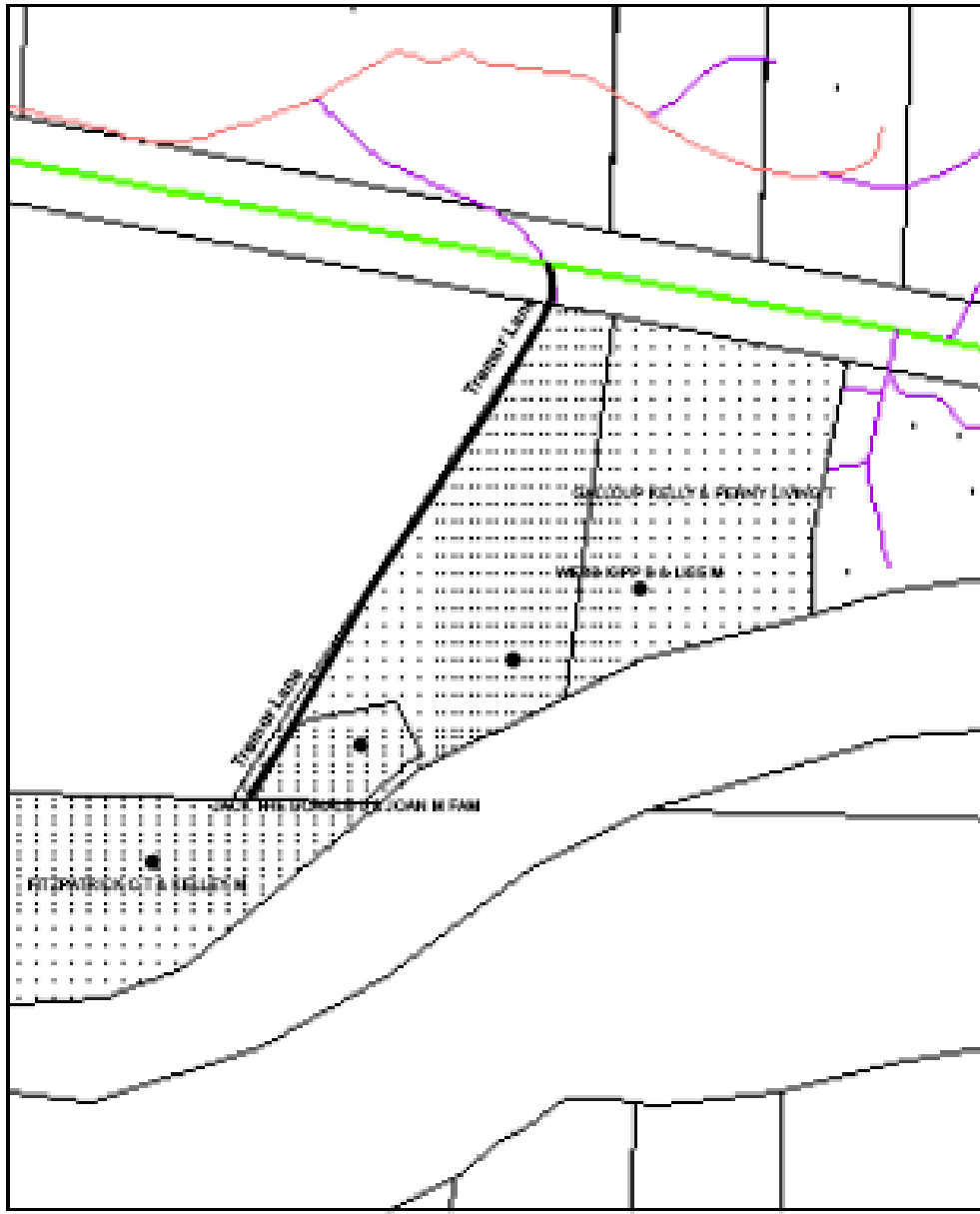
