

RESOLUTION 25-2008
A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING PROSPECT ROAD AS "PUBLIC USE ROAD"
IN MADISON COUNTY

WHEREAS, on August 1, 1988, the Board of County Commissioners issued a declaration by letter that the road commonly known as "Prospect Road" in Madison County is and has been for many years a "Public Use Road" for County purposes; and

WHEREAS, a copy of said declaration by letter and the minutes reflecting the discussion by the Board is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein as "Exhibit A;" and

WHEREAS, the subject road remains a Public Use Road; and

WHEREAS, the subject road is used by landowners to access their property.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Madison County Board of Commissioners that the road described as

Others attending the meeting included: Dick Pace, Mark Harshman, Loren Tucker, Darryl Taylor, Dana Harvey, Jim Birdsell, and Faith Larson.

Minutes of the July 25, 1988, Commissioners Meeting were approved as read.

Dana Harvey was present to discuss the installation of round top caps on the Courthouse Fence surrounding the Courthouse. Bayers moved to install round top caps on the fence surrounding the courthouse at an estimated price of \$495.00. Allhands seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Faith Larson was present to discuss repair on the Upper Ruby Road. The Commission discussed with Faith that her concerns would be taken under advisement.

Loren Tucker, Madison County Attorney, and Mark Harshman were present to discuss:

2. New Air Conditioners not working properly.
3. All purpose levies.
