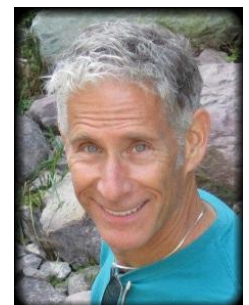
Joanne Erdall-Van De Riet – Library Director
